BRING A FILMMAKER TO YOUR SCHOOL.

Each year, EIFF hosts up to 30 filmmaker guests who attend the festival with their film, and they love to talk about the movie-making process! In order to better serve the many requests for Filmmaker visits, speakers prefer to work in a classroom setting with up to 40 students in grades 7 to 12 and post-secondary institutions. A dvd player and television monitor are required, and depending on the number of student questions, the presentation should take 45- to 60-minutes.

It is recommended, but not necessary, that students attend the filmmaker's movie screening at the Edmonton International Film Festival. Groups of 10 students or more receive discounted admission to the movie and teachers/chaperones are admitted for FREE. A \$100 speaker fee (payable to EIFF) is required for the filmmaker to visit your school.

To book a Filmmaker To Your School, fill out the form below and fax it to the EIFF at (780) 447-5242. Please pay particular attention to audience size and preferred grade level requirements. Visits will take place during the festival, which is 9 days beginning the final Friday in September, and are limited in number. Applications are accepted year-round. Participating schools will be notified by phone or e-mail on or before **September 1st**. Only those schools chosen to participate will be contacted. Due to the very limited time filmmakers have to visit the festival, we are only able to accommodate schools in the greater Edmonton area.
